

Help prevent the spread of Queensland fruit fly

This area is under a Controlled Area Notice, restricting the movement of home-grown fruits and vegetables.

Queensland fruit fly has been found in Mt Roskill. If established, this insect could have serious consequences for New Zealand's fruit growers and home gardeners.



A Controlled Area has been placed around the location the fruit fly was found. This area is divided into two zones with different rules.

You are currently in **Zone B**, which means:

- No whole fruit and vegetables grown in Zone B (except for leafy vegetables and soil-free root vegetables) can be moved out of the controlled area.
- Home-grown produce waste, soil, and planting material attached to, or in the vicinity of, fruit-bearing trees grown inside Zone B must be disposed of in Biosecurity New Zealand bins.
- No composting of home-grown fruit and vegetables or garden waste.
